



GENERAL ELECTION VOTER GUIDE

FOR THE UPCOMING ELECTION, STUTSMAN COUNTY WILL BE OFFERING 3 WAYS TO VOTE!

1. Absentee (Vote-By-Mail)

Applications are available online at <https://vote.nd.gov/absentee>

Once you fill out and return your application you will receive your ballot in the mail. You can also stop by the Courthouse and receive your ballot in person.

Once you are done filling out your ballot, return it to us in 1 of 3 ways:

1.) Mail (Postage Required)

2.) Official County Dropbox (No Postage Required). Election Dropboxes will be available in the lobby of the Courthouse (M-F 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM) as well as the Law Enforcement Center (24/7). Dropboxes will be available until 5:00 PM, November 2nd.

3.) Drop it off in person at the Auditor's Office located on the 1st floor of the Courthouse.

Note: If you voted in the June Primary, you may have already selected to receive an Absentee ballot for the upcoming General Election. To verify, you can contact our office using the info at the bottom.

2. Early Vote

The Early Voting Precinct will be open at the Courthouse from October 19th until October 30th, 2020. You will be able to come in and vote during normal business hours, Monday-Friday 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM, including over the Noon hour.

3. Vote Center

On Election Day, November 3rd, anyone that resides in Stutsman County can vote at the Jamestown Civic Center. The Vote Center will be open from 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM.
